



House Bill 5 – Community Engagement

House Bill 5 includes a local evaluation requirement that is frequently referred to as the *community engagement* component. The community engagement requirement is an opportunity for districts to showcase areas of excellence and success as well as recognize areas in need of improvement and set future goals valued in the community.

Lasara ISD has evaluated and designated performance ratings for the district and each of its campuses based on criteria set by local committees, and each district and each campus has been assigned a rating of exemplary, recognized, acceptable, or unacceptable.
